



TECHNICAL BARRIER TO TRADE (TBT) AGREEMENT TRANSPARENCY WORKSHOP

DRAFT PROGRAMME

Standards and regulations have a significant impact on trade flows. Transparency, a cornerstone of the TBT Agreement, facilitates timely access to and dialogue on evolving regulatory requirements by public and private stakeholders.

This TBT transparency workshop, targeting officials working in TBT Enquiry Points and Notification Authorities, will focus on the following areas:

- 1. **Transparency provisions**. The workshop will assist participants in connecting the dots between transparency provisions, TBT Enquiry Point functions and the work of the TBT Committee;
- 2. **Digital tools**. The workshop will put emphasis on the use of digital tools, in particular ePing, for the management of TBT information and communication with domestic stakeholders and international counterparts;
- 3. **Network of Enquiry Point officials:** The workshop will present an opportunity for enquiry point officials to learn from each other on good practices on transparency and coordination at national, regional and international levels and build relationships for future cooperation.

Participants will also have the opportunity to attend the TBT Committee's meeting dedicated to transparency and the functioning of enquiry points on 23-24 June.
