Dear colleagues,

As you are aware, Members met at an informal retreat on fisheries subsidies negotiations in Evian-les-Bains on 10 October 2022 to brainstorm on the "second wave" negotiations on fisheries subsidies.

A concrete first step on which there was wide convergence is to engage in knowledge building in the form of technical workshops with a view to better inform the negotiations. Against this background, the WTO Secretariat will organize two such workshops:

- the first workshop on 23 November 2022 will focus on the evolution of the overcapacity and overfishing disciplines. **A provisional agenda of this workshop is attached below.** Please note that <u>Interprefy and interpretation will be available</u>; and
- the second workshop will be organized in late January 2023 focused on data concerning the state of marine fisheries and state of subsidies to such fishing. The details for this workshop will follow in due course.
